Gospel Reflection

The parable in today's gospel reading is largely a story of rejection. The owner of the vineyard sends two lots of servants to collect the produce of the vineyard,

but they are rejected, and some of them are killed. Yet, rejection does not have the last word. As Jesus says, quoting one of the psalms, the stone rejected by the builders became the keystone. God raised his rejected Son from the dead and made him the foundation or the keystone of the church. Any little experience of rejection can leave us deflated; we can be tempted to give up. The parable suggests that God is not like that. In the face of rejection, God just keeps working away; he takes the experience of rejection, the rejected stone, and builds something new upon it.

Tuttavia, il rifiuto non ha l'ultima parola. Come dice Gesù, citando uno dei salmi, la pietra scartata dai costruttori è diventata la chiave di volta. Dio ha risuscitato il suo Figlio respinto dai morti e lo ha reso la fondamenta o la chiave di volta della Chiesa. Qualsiasi piccola esperienza di rifiuto può lasciarci sconfortati; possiamo essere tentati di arrenderci. La parabola suggerisce che Dio non è così. Di fronte al rifiuto, Dio continua a lavorare; prende l'esperienza del rifiuto, la pietra scartata, e costruisce qualcosa di nuovo su di essa.


