Gospel Reflection Luke 17:11–19: In this Gospel, Jesus heals ten lepers, yet only one comes back to thank Him. His gratitude is simple, yet it reveals a heart truly open to God's love. How often do we receive blessings and forget to pause and give thanks? Jesus calls us to notice His presence in our lives and to respond with gratitude. Like the one leper who returned, let us take the time to say "thank you" to God, not just with words, but with our hearts. Gratitude transforms us—it turns a simple healing into a deeper encounter with the Lord.
