Reflection – Luke 18:9–14: In today’s Gospel, Jesus reminds us of the importance of humility in our relationship with God. The Pharisee boasts about his good deeds, while the tax collector quietly asks for mercy. Jesus tells us that it is the humble heart that is justified before God.This passage invites us to reflect on our own hearts. Are we proud of our achievements, or do we recognize our need for God’s grace? True prayer comes from honesty and humility, acknowledging that we rely on God’s mercy every day. Let us approach the Lord like the tax collector, confident in His love and forgiveness.
