GOSPEL REFLECTION

In today's Gospel (John 9:1-41), we hear the story of a man born blind whom Jesus heals in a remarkable way.

**Jesus doesn't just restore his physical sight;
He opens his eyes to the deeper truth of God's love.**

This miracle reminds us that we, too, can be blind in different ways—spiritually or emotionally. Jesus, the light of the world, comes to heal our blindness and to guide us toward a fuller understanding of His mercy and grace.

**As we reflect on this healing, we are called to ask ourselves:
Where in our lives are we still blind? What areas need the healing touch of Jesus? When we experience His love, it transforms us, just as it did for the blind man. Let us allow Jesus to open our eyes to see the world as He does and share His light with others, leading them out of darkness and into His love.**

RIFLESSIONE SUL VANGELO

Nel Vangelo di oggi (Giovanni 9,1-41), ascoltiamo la storia di un uomo nato cieco che Gesù guarisce in un modo straordinario. Gesù non restaura solo la sua vista fisica; apre i suoi occhi alla verità più profonda dell'amore di Dio. Questo miracolo ci ricorda che anche noi possiamo essere ciechi in modi diversi—spiritualmente o emotivamente. Gesù, la luce del mondo, viene a guarire la nostra cecità e a guidarci verso una comprensione più piena della Sua misericordia e grazia.

Mentre riflettiamo su questa guarigione, siamo chiamati a chiederci: Dove nella nostra vita siamo ancora ciechi? Quali aree hanno bisogno del tocco garante di Gesù? Quando sperimentiamo il Suo amore, questo ci trasforma, proprio come ha fatto per il cieco. Permettiamo a Gesù di aprire i nostri occhi per vedere il mondo come lo vede Lui e condividere la Sua luce con gli altri, conducendoli fuori dalle tenebre e nel Suo amore.
