Gospel Reflection

The Gospel of this Fifth Sunday of Lent tells us of the resurrection of Lazarus (cf. Jn 11:53). Before the sealed tomb of his friend Lazarus, Jesus "cried with a loud voice: 'Lazarus, come out!'. And the dead man came out, his hands and feet bound with bandages, and his face wrapped with a cloth". He calls us to come out of the darkness of that prison in which we are enclosed, content with a false, selfish and mediocre life. "Come out!", he says to us, "Come out!". It is an invitation

to true freedom, to allow ourselves to be seized by these words of Jesus who repeats them to each one of us today. It is an invitation to let ourselves be freed from the "bandages", from the bandages of pride.



Chrism Mass

This year's Chrism Mass will take place on Tuesday, 4 April 2023 at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. Chrism Mass is a special liturgy celebrated during Holy Week, usually on Holy Thursday. During this Mass, the bishop blesses the oils that will be used in the administration of the sacraments throughout the year. There are three types of holy oils that are blessed during the Chrism Mass: Oil of the Catechumens, Oil of the Sick, Sacred Chrism.

During the Chrism Mass, the priests of the diocese also renew their vows of service to God and the Church, and the bishop blesses the assembly with the sacred chrism.
