We are here because of the action of the Holy Spirit on the First Pentecost when the apostles experienced its Presence in the wind and tongues of fire. We are here because of the action of the Holy Spirit at our baptism and confirmation, transforming us into the People of God and calling us to serve the Lord. We just have to be open to the Holy Spirit. Do you recognize the times that you have been open to the Holy Spirit and the times that you have ignored its prompting?

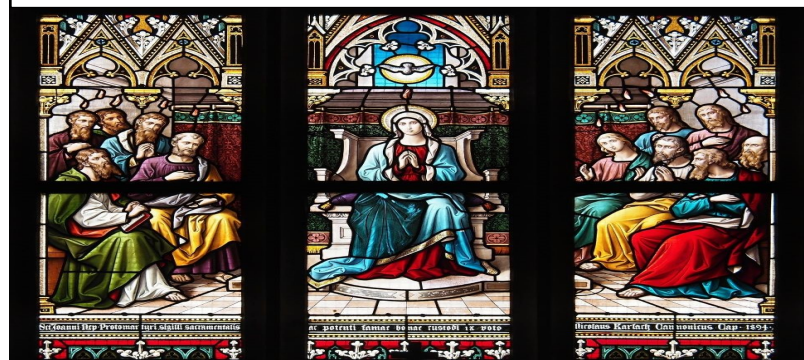

**Marriage Convalidation Invitation**

Are you married civilly but not yet in the Catholic Church? We warmly invite you to consider having your marriage convalidated in the Church.

Convalidation is the Church's way of bringing your civil marriage into full communion with the sacramental life of the Church, so that your marriage may be fully recognized as a sacramental marriage. It is a grace-filled opportunity to renew your commitment before God and deepen your life of faith together.

Couples will meet with the pastor for two preparation meetings. Required documents include: a recent baptism certificate, civil marriage certificate (long form), and a marriage preparation course certificate. If you belong to another parish, a permission letter from your pastor is also required.

A Convalidation Mass is being planned for May 8, 2027 under the auspices of the Loved Flock Catholic Charismatic Group.
