This will definitely encourage our young ones to put their heart and soul into singing.

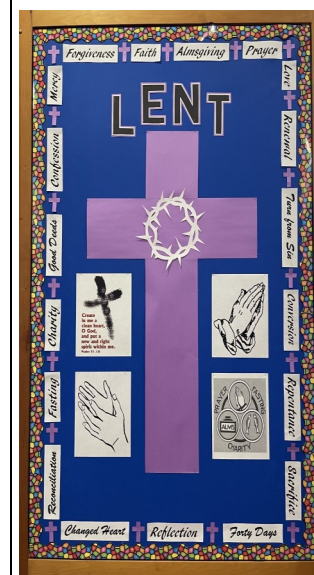
