Gospel Reflection: Jesus begins His mission by walking along the Sea of Galilee and calling ordinary people to follow Him. They were simple fishermen, not important or powerful, yet Jesus saw something special in them. When He said, "Come after me," they left their nets and trusted His voice. They were willing to leave what was familiar because they believed He was leading them to something greater.

This Gospel reminds us that Jesus still walks into our daily lives today. He calls us in the middle of our work, our family life, and even our struggles. He does not wait for us to be perfect; He simply asks us to follow Him. When we respond with trust, He can change our hearts and guide our lives in a new and beautiful way.
