**Maggio è il mese di Maria:** Il rosario sarà recitato 30 minuti prima della messa italiana feriali e domenicali durante il mese di maggio. Tutti sono invitati a partecipare.

**Reflection** – In today’s Gospel (John 14:1–12), Jesus speaks words of deep comfort: “Do not let your hearts be troubled.” He does not remove the mystery of life, but fills it with trust in God. He promises that He goes to prepare a place for us in the Father’s house, revealing that our life is not without direction but is ordered toward communion with God. When Jesus says, “I am the way, the truth, and the life,” He shows that He is not only a guide but the very path to the Father. Faith, therefore, is not only belief but a living relationship with Christ. Even in uncertainty, we are invited to remain in Him, who leads us to eternal life.

**Riflessione** – Nel Vangelo di oggi (Giovanni 14,1-12), Gesù dice: “Non sia turbato il vostro cuore.” Egli non elimina il mistero della vita, ma lo riempie di fiducia in Dio. Promette di prepararci un posto nella casa del Padre, rivelando che la nostra vita non è senza direzione, ma orientata alla comunione con Dio. Quando Gesù dice: “Io sono la via, la verità e la vita,” Egli non è solo una guida, ma la via stessa verso il Padre. La fede non è solo credere, ma vivere una relazione viva con Cristo. Anche nell’incertezza, siamo chiamati a rimanere in Lui che ci conduce alla vita eterna.

**Marriage Convalidation Invitation**

Are you married civilly but not yet in the Catholic Church? We warmly invite you to consider having your marriage convalidated in the Church.

The Church teaches that Catholics are called to celebrate marriage according to the canonical form for it to be fully recognized as a sacramental marriage. Convalidation is the Church’s beautiful way of addressing this situation and bringing your marriage into full communion with the sacramental life of the Church.

A convalidation is the process by which a civil marriage is received and blessed by the Church, so that the couple may fully live their vocation as husband and wife in Christ. It is a grace-filled opportunity to renew your commitment before God and to deepen your life of faith together.

Couples interested in convalidation will be asked to meet with the pastor for two preparation meetings. Required documents include: a recent baptism certificate, your civil marriage certificate (long form), and a marriage preparation course certificate. If you belong to another parish, a permission letter from your local pastor will also be required. Additional documentation may be requested depending on individual circumstances.

A Convalidation Mass is being planned for May 29.
